## **Types of Emergency Drills**

It's essential that every teacher and student be familiar with these different drills, their signals, and the location and position each person is to take under the direction of the teacher/staff member. Emergency drills are held once a year so that we can respond better in times of an emergency.

If the school is ever evacuated, our safety meeting point is the baseball diamond at Stoner Park. Once there, Mentor Teachers should line up with the other New West Staff members so your Mentor students can find you. Attendance will be taken for those students that are present. This attendance list will be then cross-checked with the Lounge Sign In/Outs for the day to determine if any students are unaccounted for.

| Shelter In Place                                   | Alternating long and<br>short bells or<br>commands of<br>"SHELTER IN<br>PLACE!" is given by<br>teacher or staff<br>member                            | If In The Lounge: Immediately go to the classroom, close windows and<br>blinds, and move away from the windows. Remain in place calm and quiet<br>until directed to evacuate or until the emergency is over.<br>In The Classroom: Close windows and blinds, and move away from the<br>windows. Remain in place, calm and quiet until directed to evacuate or<br>until the emergency is over.<br>Could be used for Natural Disasters, Inclement Weather, or Police activity<br>in the area.  | One long bell or oral<br>notification from staff or<br>administration the drill is over |
| Lock Down /<br>Active Shooter /<br>Campus Intruder | Three short bells<br>repeated over and<br>over (international<br>SOS call) or<br>commands of "LOCK<br>DOWN!" given by<br>administrator or<br>teacher | If In The Lounge: Immediately go to the classroom, close windows and<br>blinds, and move away from the windows. DO NOT OPEN the door for<br>any reason or for any person.
