Local Assignment Option EC 44258.7(c)(d) may be used to assign a teacher that is employed on a full-time basis who teaches any grade of K-12, inclusive, and who has special skills and preparation outside of his or her credential authorization, with his or her consent, be assigned to teach an elective course in the area of the special skills or preparation, for a maximum of one year, with the option of annual renewal, provided that the assignment is first approved by a committee on assignments
